Class supplies:

Handwriting pen (blue or black ink, roller ball e.g. Stabilo Move Easy)

A packet of coloured pencils

A pencil sharpener

2 erasers

A pair of scissors (left handed when necessary)

A transparent 15 cm ruler (in their pencil case)

A transparent 30 cm ruler (can be kept in their drawer at school)

Pair of compasses (to be kept in their drawer at school)

4 large glue sticks (1 in pencil case, 2 in tray, 1 at home)

USB memory stick (named electronically and physically)

A pair of indoor shoes, please make sure they have a hard sole. (fire drills in the middle of winter/wet weather result in ruined shoes and cold feet!)

A box of tissues – to be shared with the class. (It's nicer for their noses!)

Art materials: - Most children should have this already from previous years

An A3 art folder

A painting apron or an old shirt to protect clothes

Paintbrushes in different sizes with soft bristles and hard bristles;

Watercolour paints in a variety of forms such as dry blocks, tubes Wax crayons

A kitchen sponge

An old rag for wiping brushes

A plastic plate for mixing paints

Indoor sport shoes, not black soled Shorts/tracksuit bottoms and T-shirt Sports bag
